

Sandra's Chemo Cap Pattern



Cast on 100 (105, 110, 115) st on circ. needle and join, being careful not to twist stitches. Place marker for beginning of round.

Knit 5 rounds for rolled edge.

For Single Color Hat: Begin Ridge Pattern:

Row 1: purl

Row 2: knit

Repeat these 2 rows 4 times to make 4 ridges.

Eyelet Row: *k1, yo, k2tog*

Repeat to end of round. Knit one round.

Now repeat the Pattern rows 1 & 2 four more times.

Continue in Stocking stitch until piece measures 5 inches or desired length from cast on edge.

For Two Color Hat: Begin Pattern:

Row 1: purl in Main Color

Row 2: knit in MC

Row 3: purl in MC

Row 4: knit in Contrast Color

Row 5: purl in CC

Row 6: knit in MC

Row 7: purl in MC

Knit one round

Continue in MC for eyelet round and then Knit 1 round.

Repeat 7 rows of ridge pattern, working the CC on Rows 2 and 3, rather than rows 4 and 5.

Continue in Main Color as for plain hat.

Materials: 100 yards of light worsted or DK cotton yarn and about 25 yards of contrast color yarn.

#5 or 6 circular needle, 16 or 20";
and a set of # 5 or 6 dpn's,
or size to get gauge

Gauge: 20 st= 4 inches

Model is done in Saucy cotton yarn.

Sizes: 20", 21", 22", 23"

Finishing:

Decrease 0 (5, 10, 15) st evenly round next round. Knit one round.

Begin Decreases for all sizes:

k 8, k2tog; repeat around. Knit one round.

k7, k2tog; repeat to end of round,
Knit one round. Continue in this manner,
ending with *k1, k2tog;* repeat to end of round.

Knit one round, then K2, k2tog for last round.
Cut yarn and fasten off. Weave yarn ends in.

Decoration:

Weave a ribbon or knitted cord thru eyelets and tie in a bow; fasten on a pin, flower or barette; add a knitted bow as in the photo above:

Cast on 11 st. Knit 2 rows, work in stockinette stitch, keeping 2 st in garter at each edge, for 3 inches, knit 2 more rows and bind off. Thread the bow thru two of the eyelet holes.
