

Lace Chevron Pattern

Here's an easy, lacey chevron pattern for a scarf that won't be just garter or ribbing and would look great in any of the novelty yarns. It could also be very nice in a tweed or multicolor wool, or in a light weight yarn for a dressy scarf. Use an appropriate needle for your yarn and increase the number of pattern repeats for lighter yarns.

The example below is for a chunky wt on size 10-10.5 needles.

Lace Chevron Pattern

once you do a few rows, you'll have it memorized!

Cast on: 31 stitches and purl one row.

Pattern Stitch:

Row 1: K1, *YO, K3, Slip one st. as if to knit, K2tog, PSSO, K 3, YO, K1* repeat * to * twice more.

Row 2: Purl across

YO= Yarn over

PSSO= pass slipped stitch over the K2tog just worked, thus decr. 2 stitches total.
